

Remember Marcus?



Meet Marcus. He is 15-months-old. By the time Marcus is 2-years-old, he will have inhaled 760 cigarettes. Marcus lives with a smoker — his dad.

Toxic chemicals from secondhand smoke settle on child safety seats long after the smoke is gone.

Chemicals found in secondhand smoke:

- carbon monoxide found in car exhaust
- ammonia found in cleaners
- cadmium found in batteries
- arsenic found in rat poison
